The winning KS1 and KS2 pupil's class will win a visit to a local art gallery near their school (transport and entry included) and receive a signed print.



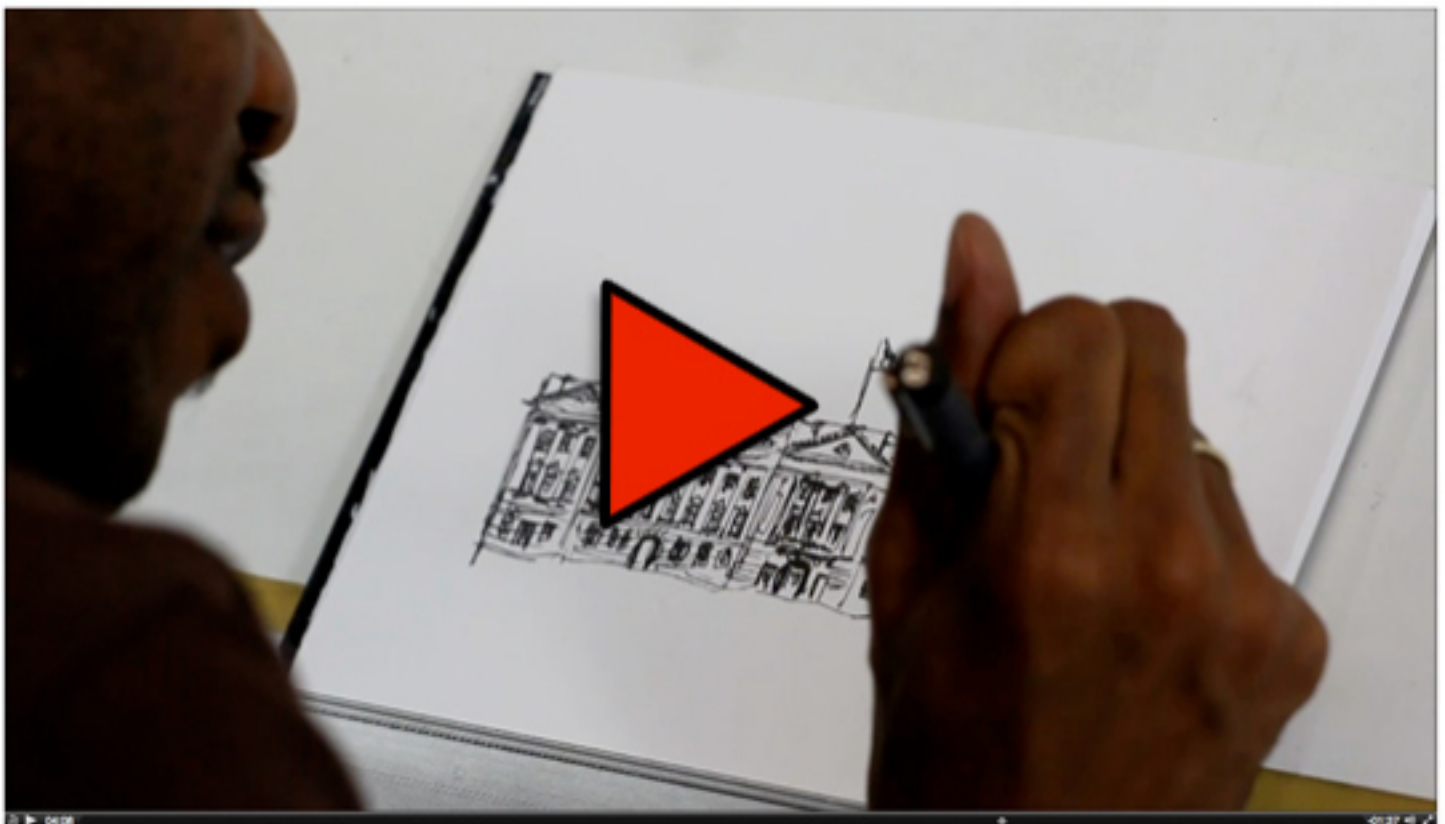
Runners up will receive £250 worth of STAEDTLER products for their school.
